# Worcester Area College Basketball Association - Men's Report

## Co-Players of the Week:

**Maurice Horton, Quinsigamond CC, Sophomore, Forward (Worcester, MA/Burncoat):**

In a monumental three-win week for QCC, Horton scored 68 points, pulled down 38 rebounds and tallied 12 steals in victories over Northern Essex, nationally ranked Gateway and Ben Franklin. Perhaps he was at his best versus defending regional champion Gateway, the sixth ranked team nationally, when he registered 25 points, 12 rebounds and four steals. On the season, Horton is averaging 21 points and 9 rebounds per contest.

**Ryan Cain, WPI, Senior, Guard (Webster, MA/St. John's):**

Cain averaged 27.3 points en route to helping WPI win three games in four days. He started his impressive string by pouring in a season-high 30 points in a 81-70 victory over Endicott. Cain then earned MVP honors at the Raiders Engineers Classic after scoring 27 points in a win versus Case Western Reserve and 25 points in the championship victory against host MOSE. On the week, Cain, who played 118 of a possible 120 minutes, connected on 24-of-42 (57.1%) shots from the field while adding 13 rebounds and eight assists.
