Player of the Week:

Ryan Cain, WPI, Senior, Guard (Webster, MA/St. John's)

Cain became the WPI's all-time leading scorer with 17 points in a 67-57 NEWMAC regular season title-clinching victory over Coast Guard on Saturday. His free throws early in the first half helped him surpass Orville Bailey's previous record of 1,757 career points. Cain ends the regular season with 1,773 points and hopes to improve on that mark when WPI hosts the NEWMAC semifinals and championship this weekend. He also scored 28 points with four assists in a home win over Wheaton on Thursday night. For the week, Cain connected on an eye-popping 8-of-11 attempts from behind the three-point arc

Rookie of the Week:

Mark Alexander, Clark, Freshman, Forward (Providence, RI/Marianapolis Prep)

Alexander averaged 12.5 points, 4.0 assists, and 2.5 steals in Clark's 2-0 week. The first-year forward poured in a team-high 17 points on 7-of-13 shooting from the field, and had five steals and four assists in Clark's 81-73 victory over MIT. He chipped in with eight points and four assists in a win against Springfield earlier in the week. With the two victories, the Cougars earned a home game in this week's NEWMAC Tournament.

Ryan Wilcox, Nichols, Freshman, Center (West Granby, CT)

Wilcox posted 19 points and pulled down 10 rebounds in a win over Roger Williams and followed that up with 18 points off 7-of-8 shooting and four blocks in a win over New England College. Wilcox averaged 14.2 points upon earning a spot in the starting line-up back in January and has scored in double figures in seven straight games.
