HILL GUIDES UMASS-DARTMOUTH PAST FITCHBURG STATE

FITCHBURG, Mass. – UMASS-Dartmouth's **Joseph Hill** (Newburyport, MA/Valley Jr. Warriors) scored two goals as the Corsairs defeated Fitchburg State College, 3-2, Wednesday night in non-conference men's hockey action at the Landry Rink on the campus of Fitchburg State College.

UMD improved to 4-1-0 overall while FSC fell to 3-3-1 on the season.

The Corsairs struck first on a power play tally by Hill with 7:06 remaining in the first period. The goal that gave the visitors a 1-0 advantage was set up by **Mickey Dudley** (Douglas, MA/Boston Jr. Bruins).

The score remained 1-0 UMASS-Dartmouth into the middle stanza when Hill struck for his second of the night to double the visitors lead with 16:06 to play in the period assisted by **Jason Stahl** (Londonderry, NH/Valley Jr. Warriors).

The Falcons took advantage of a 5-on-3 power play to cut the deficit to 2-1 at the 14:42 mark of the second when **Matt Arsenault** (Gardner, MA/Gardner) found the top shelf on a cross-ice pass through the bottom of the slot by **Billy Pescosolido** (Framingham, MA/Walpole Express). **Stephen Schofield** (Valley Village, CA/Bay State Breakers) also assisted on the goal.

Just as it had opened the second period, UMASS-Dartmouth began the third with a goal at the 1:44 from **Nick Paquin** (Warwick, RI/Winchendon Academy) assisted by **Paul Moran** (Rockville Centre, NY/Boston Jr. Bulldogs) for a 3-1 cushion.

John Goffredo (Washingtonville, NY/Boston Harbor Wolves) brought the hosts back to within one at 3-2 on an unassisted breakaway tally with 12:22 to play in regulation.

Corsair netminder **Jeff Green** (Medway, MA/Valley Jr. Warriors) turned away 40 shots in the victory while FSC goaltender **Devan McConnell** (Lake Stevens, WA/St. Louis Jr. Blues) made 44 saves in the defeat.
